NOTES:

If the apartments are occupied by only two people, then Sahara will do roommate matching and each tenant will sign a separate lease and only be responsible for payment of his or her own rent.

However, for more than two residents in the apartment, all proposed tenants should be coming as a group, and there will be only one lease for the apartment with all residents financially liable for the lease. That is in legal terms there will be joint and several liability for the lease. In such a case, if one of the tenants drops out or leaves the apartment the other tenants have to pay the departing tenants rent, but will be able to bring a new tenant to replace the departing tenant, who must qualify under Sahara's normal application criteria and go through the standard application procedures.
